

Lead Professional Educator Designation Pathway

IET's training and support for teachers seeking the Lead Professional Educator Designation empowers participants to grow as teacher leaders, leverage instructional expertise, make data-driven decisions, and foster collaborative partnerships. Teachers attend and engage in four core teacher leadership-focused trainings, each divided into synchronous and asynchronous virtual sessions over the course of seven days, and individualized support from an NIET Specialist.

Session Date Windows:

Based on the number of cohorts final dates will not be scheduled until June 30, 2024. Below are the windows to expect the training to be scheduled.

Session 1 - (1 day training) July 15th - July 26th

Session 2 - (2 day training) August 19th - August 30th

Session 3 - (2 day training)
October 21st - November 1st

Session 4 - (2 day training) January 21st - January 31st
