## Learning Recovery Acceleration Series

Investing in high-quality instruction is the best way to accelerate learning and narrow achievement gaps, particularly following disruptions caused by the pandemic. NIET has a five-part series that will strengthen teaching and learning in ways that benefit students now and for years to come.



Session 1: Using and analyzing data, as well as communicating needs to families and students

- Analyze reliable data to determine trends in student needs from unfinished learning
- Examine an accelerated learning approach through standards and data trend analysis
- Plan for students and teachers to reflect, monitor, and communicate progress
- Create a coaching plan



Session 2: Maximizing collaborative structures to support learning recovery

- Unpack the role of the leadership team in supporting teachers to accelerate learning
- Learn specifically how administrators and teacher leaders can strengthen their capacity to support accelerated learning
- Plan for using collaborative structures, like PLCs and planning time, to support teachers



Session 3: Planning for accelerated learning options and individualized learning

- Examine models for grouping students and identify key opportunities throughout the day
- Plan to incorporate accelerated learning in core instruction, small group, and individual instruction
- Strengthen the coaching plan

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## Additional, optional sessions Available in-person or virtually

Session 4: Strengthening content-specific strategies for learning recovery in math and English language arts (Recommended for teachers and leaders; not grade-level specific. Each content area is one day.)

- Identify skills critical to student mastery of essential standards
- Deconstruct critical skills in order to scaffold and segment accelerated learning in a logical order
- Develop thinking strategies to support student mastery of critical skills
- Define ways to incorporate techniques for increasing student engagement and student ownership of learning
- Create coaching questions



Session 5: Setting up effective summer learning opportunities (Recommended for district, school, and teacher leaders. This session is one day.)

- Plan for and implement systems to support skill-specific accelerated learning practices
- Define key elements of scope and sequence inclusive of strategies to address student needs in core instruction, small group, and individual instruction
- Incorporate student engagement and ownership
- Create coaching questions
